Rex Minerals' Draft PEPR Management Plans for: Coastal and Marine (St Vincent's Gulf), Ground Water and Surface Water

When: 1.30 pm, Sunday 20th August 2017
Where: Pine Point Hall

As part of its Program for Environment Protection and Rehabilitation (PEPR), Rex Minerals is developing a number of Management Plans for the Hillside Mine. These Plans must describe how the Company intends to operate the Mine to meet the range of conditions imposed by Government when, in 2014, it granted a Mining Lease for Hillside.

Three of these draft Management Plans – on the coastal/marine environment, groundwater and surface water - are now available for community consultation, as required by the State Government.

To ensure these Plans take account of local concerns, expectations and knowledge, the HMCV Working Group on Water invites you to attend a Community Information and Discussion Session to give local residents and other interested people an opportunity to obtain information and contribute to a full and open discussion on water-related issues.

Topics to be discussed for each plan will include:

- Rex's planned control and mitigation strategies, monitoring program, how the community will be kept informed and how complaints will be dealt with.

Information will be provided by Rex Minerals and representatives from the Mineral Resources Division (Dept. of Premier and Cabinet). There will be ample time for community participants to ask questions, raise concerns and contribute their views on each Plan.

Why your participation in these sessions is important

When approved, the PEPR becomes a key operational document used by Government to regulate the Hillside Mine Operations. It is therefore vital that we, as a community (and especially those living in close proximity to the planned mine) take this opportunity to have input into the PEPR document's Management Plans.
